Lois I. Helm, being first duly sworn, deposes and says

- 1. I am a member of the Woman's Christian Temperance Union (WCTU), an organization founded in 1874 promoting Christian values including temperance. The WCTU in the nineteenth century had a role in developing the Prohibition Party.
- 2. For purposes of promoting the Prohibition Party, I worked to organize a Prohibition Committee in Indiana in about the late 2002 early 2003 period, and sought recognition of the entity from then Chairman Earl F. Dodge.
- 3. Mr. Dodge refused to grant recognition. His behavior left an unfavorable impression on me concerning him not supporting this action of promoting the Prohibition Party, and of instead having an apparent desire to be surrounded by members with whom he is familiar and can control. I brought this situation to the attention of our National President, Sarah F. Ward.
- 4. I did not receive a notice of the June 2003 meetings which Earl F. Dodge conducted in Colorado.
- 5. The Indiana Prohibition Committee was recognized by the majority "Webb group" Tennessee meeting at the genuine PNC quadrennial "nominating convention."
