3. Pursuant to the PNC Bylaws, I signed
 - (a) a petition (attached) to convene the requisite “biennial meeting” so as to void the rump meetings and convene the contemplated quadrennial “nominating convention” and
 - (b) a “proxy” (attached).
4. I deem the so-called “Webb group” as the PNC majority, and deny the charge of having “organized a new group,” but is in fact the one, indivisible, continuing PNC, the same as it always was.
